Picasso was born on October 25, 1881 in the city of Malaga, Spain.

Picasso has 23 words in his name! Picasso was baptized Pablo Diego José Francisco de Paula Juan Nepomuceno María de los Remedios Cipriano de la Santísima Trinidad Mártir Patricio Clito Ruiz y Picasso.

Picasso's dad, Ruiz, decided to start teaching him art at the young age of 7. However, by the time Picasso was 13 years old, his dad decided to give up painting for good as he thought that Picasso was a far better painter than he was.

Picasso completed his first painting of a bull fighter when he was 9.

In between his Blue and Rose Periods, Pablo Picasso moved to France.

Picasso's first job was with an art dealer named Pere Menach.

He started the type of art work called cubism with another artist.

He had periods of time when he worked in a certain way.

He died on 8 April 1973.
