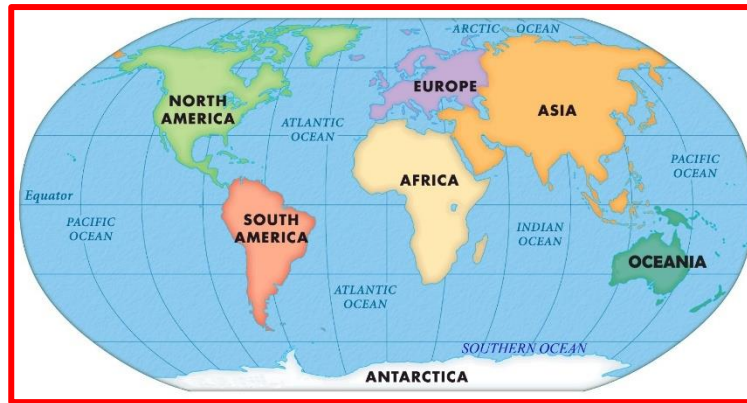




- Water covers over 70 % of the Earth's surface. The other 30 % is land.

- There are 7 continents on Earth Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Oceania.
- At one time in the past, all the land was joined in a **supercontinent**.

globe	a spherical model of the Earth
map	a picture of a particular area of the Earth drawn to scale on a flat surface.
ocean	a wide area of salty water, which is very deep.
sea	usually part of a larger ocean that is partially enclosed by land, shallower than ocean
continent	a very large block of land
atlas	a book of maps which can show much more information than a globe.
city	a large and important town where many people live and work
coast	the land next to the ocean
Equator	the imaginary circle around the earth that is halfway between the North and South Poles
North Pole	the point on the earth's surface that is farthest north
South Pole	the point on the earth's surface that is farthest south
