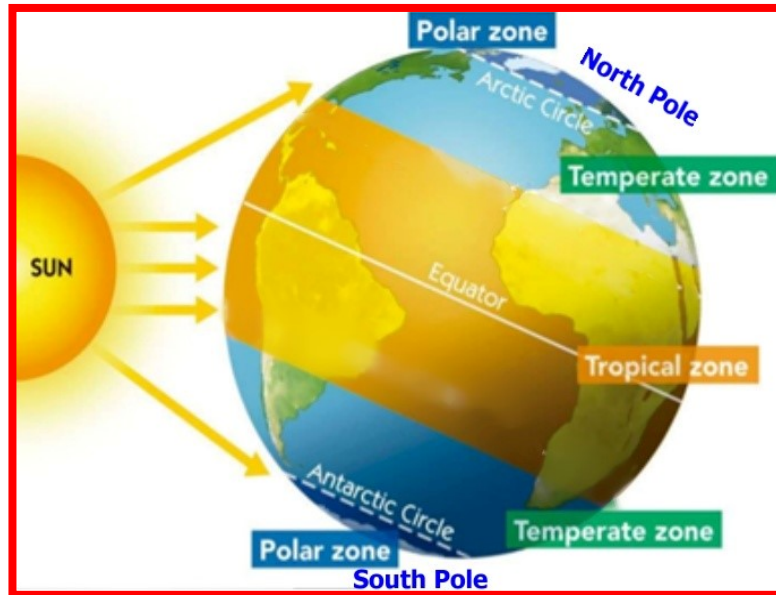

2 Million native people call The Arctic 'home'!

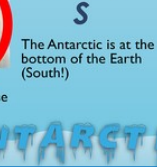
Average Yearly Temperature

Animals and plants in deserts have special ways of keeping alive.



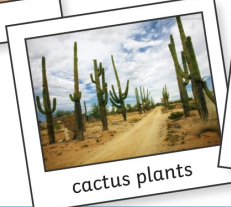

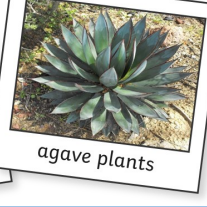

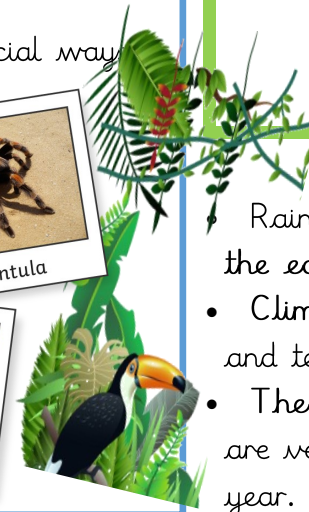
