- The Mediterranean Sea is a sea of the Atlantic Ocean almost completely enclosed by land: on the north by Europe, on the south by Africa, and on the east by Asia.
- The sea was an important route for merchants and travelers of ancient times

- Greece is the southernmost country in the EU.
- It has around 2000 islands and Crete is the biggest.
- The capital city is Athens



The Peloponnese Peninsula is separated from the mainland Greece by the Corinth Canal.

- ⇒ The first Olympic games took place on Peloponnese
- ⇒ The ancient cities of Sparta and Corinth were here

canal	a channel of water made by humans for boat transportation
