Vocabulary

Crucified - put (someone) to death by nailing or binding them to a cross, especially as an ancient punishment.



God - Creation - Fall - People of God - Incarnation - Gospel - SALVATION - Kingdom of God

Jesus' crucifixion is remembered on Good Friday.



The events of Palm Sunday, Holy week and Easter are a combined mixture of the emotions of joy and sadness.

The church remembers and marks the events of Holy Week in a variety of ways.

The events of Holy Week reveal what Jesus came to earth to do - God's salvation plan.



Palm Sunday- the Sunday before Easter, on which Christ's entry into Jerusalem is celebrated in many Christian churches by processions in which branches of palms are carried.

Temple- a place to worship.

Last Supper- The last meal Jesus ate with his disciples.

Gethsemane- Where Jesus was arrested.

Good Friday- The day Jesus died.

Easter Sunday- The day Jesus resurrected.

Resurrection- the rising of Christ from the dead.
