Trust - firm belief in the reliability, truth, or ability of someone or something.

Betrayal- an act of deliberate disloyalty.

Forgiveness- the action or process of forgiving or being forgiven.

Loyalty- giving or showing firm and constant support or allegiance to a person or institution.

Gethsemane-the garden outside Jerusalem mentioned in Mark 14 as the scene of the arrest of Jesus

Jerusalem - a city in Western Asia.

Judas- the Disciple who betrayed Jesus.

Peter - one of Jesus's disciples and denied knowing Him three times.
