Bible texts are used to answer questions about the characteristics and nature of God.

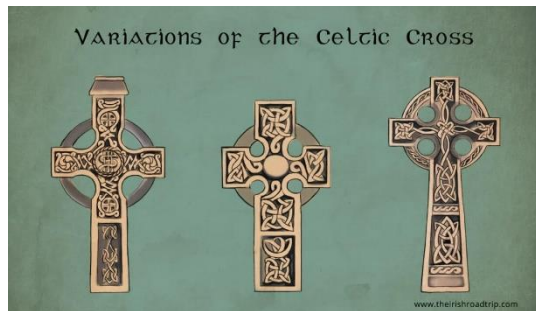
God the Father- the creator and sustainer of all things.
