

## Art & Design Textiles

### **EYFS**

- Handle and manipulate materials such as threads, wool, raffia, grass and used them to weave on different frames e.g. railings outside, garden trellis pieces.
- Name colours, talk about how a material feels e.g. rough, soft, smooth etc. and can identify common shapes in their work.
- Use simple threading cards and designs as preparation for sewing.

Y2

- Sort different materials and discuss how they have sorted them.
- Pulled apart different materials and threads to explore how they are made.
- Select materials they wish to use in a piece of weaving: choosing colours that complement or contrast or for personal preference.
- Weave using a basic over and under technique.
- Sew a line of running stitch.
- Thread a needle, cut, glue and trim material.

Y4

- Build upon KS1 experiences with exploring different materials.
- Discriminate between materials to create a specific texture.
- Know that there are different techniques for tie dye and be able to explain how they are different and what type of pattern each technique creates. Use taught techniques correctly and choose one for a final piece of work.
- Refine and alter ideas and explain choices using an artistic vocabulary (See vocabulary sheets.)

### **UKS 2**

Y6

- Know the correct technique for using wax to create a batik.
- Understand the principle of wax resist.
- Experiment with using batik safely.
- Use the exploration and understanding of the techniques to design to plan and design a finished piece of work.
- Know that embellishing techniques such as stitching can be used to add texture, detail or pattern to a piece of work.
- Be expressive and analytical to adapt, extend and justify their work and provide evidence in sketchbooks.
