Vocabulary

We can use input devices (microphones) to record audio and output devices (headphones) to listen to audio.



People who make audio can copyright it meaning others can't use it without permission.

You can edit a recording after you make it to remove any mistakes or long pauses.

There are now thousands of podcasts available to listen to on a range of subjects.

You can edit podcasts by adding sound effects or background music.



It is important to listen to audio recordings back so you can evaluate them.

Audio - sound.

Input device - plugged into the device e.g. microphone.

Output device - come out of the device e.g. sound through headphones.

Podcast - digital audio made available for people to listen to.

Edit - alter or improve something.

Layer - break something up into separate layers.

Import - to put something into your recording such as sound effects.

Record - to convert sound to be listened to afterwards.

Export - to save your audio so it can be listened to.

Evaluate - give opinions on the audio produced
