Voy... I go

We already know how to say 'I go' in Spanish. Let's learn how to say other people go. The special pattern that the verb is in below is called a PARADIGM.

Ir - to go

I go	voy	we go	vamos
you go (1 person)	vas	you go (group of people)	vais
he/she goes	va	they go	van

Prepositions to describe position

al lado de - next to  
 enfrente de - opposite

Contractions

a + el → al      de + el → del

When going to a feminine place...

Vamos a la panadería. We go to the bakery.

But when going to a masculine place...

Vamos al mercado. We go to the market.

al lado de la panadería next to the bakery  
 al lado del mercado next to the market.

There are 2 ways of saying this in Spanish.

Éste es el museo. (masculine noun)  
 This is the museum.

Ésta es la farmacia. (feminine noun)  
 This is the pharmacy.

When using a Bilingual dictionary, take care not to confuse nouns with verbs.
