Epifanía (Epiphany)

In Spain, 'el roscón de reyes' (the crown of the Kings) is a



special cake eaten during Epiphany. If the hidden toy (la figurita) is in your piece of cake you can be King or Queen for the day. However, if you have the bean (el habo) in your piece, tradition says that you must pay for the cake!

Pronunciation tips

Phonics

Vowels are always pronounced

in the same way

A - ah

E - eh (ay)

I - ee

O - oh

U - oo

g is pronounced as 'h' when it is followed by an e or i as in gira, el gimnasio, la geografía.

This g is pronounced as a hard g, as in dog because it is not followed by e or i

'd' is pronounced 'th' eg, el comedor, la entrada.
