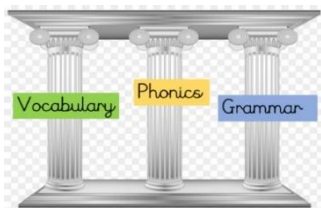

How to say which part of your body hurts

For SINGULAR nouns...



Me duele la mano.
My hand hurts.



Me duele la nariz.
My nose hurts.

For PLURAL nouns...



Me duelen las piernas.
My legs hurt.

n is added because legs is a plural noun.



Me duelen los pies.
My feet

We already know the parts of the face, now let's look at the parts of the body. To help you remember them, the masculine and feminine parts are labelled on separate sides.

El cuerpo **The body**

the head / La cabeza

the back / La espalda

the hand / La mano

the leg / La pierna

the knee / La rodilla

El hombro / the shoulder

El brazo / the arm

El estómago / the stomach

El dedo / the finger

the foot / El pie

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Give your partner commands to move different parts of the body.

Levanta el brazo izquierdo. *Lift up your left arm.*

Gira la cabeza. *Turn your head.*

Mueve la pierna derecha. *Move your right leg.*
