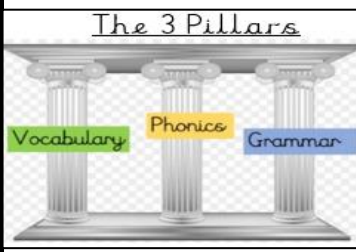

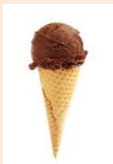

Me encanta el helado de chocolate.

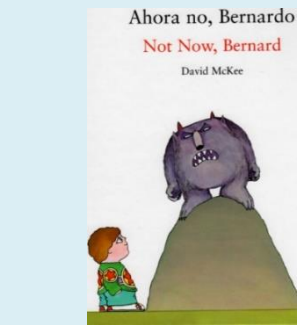
Odio el helado de limón.

'Hello Mum.'

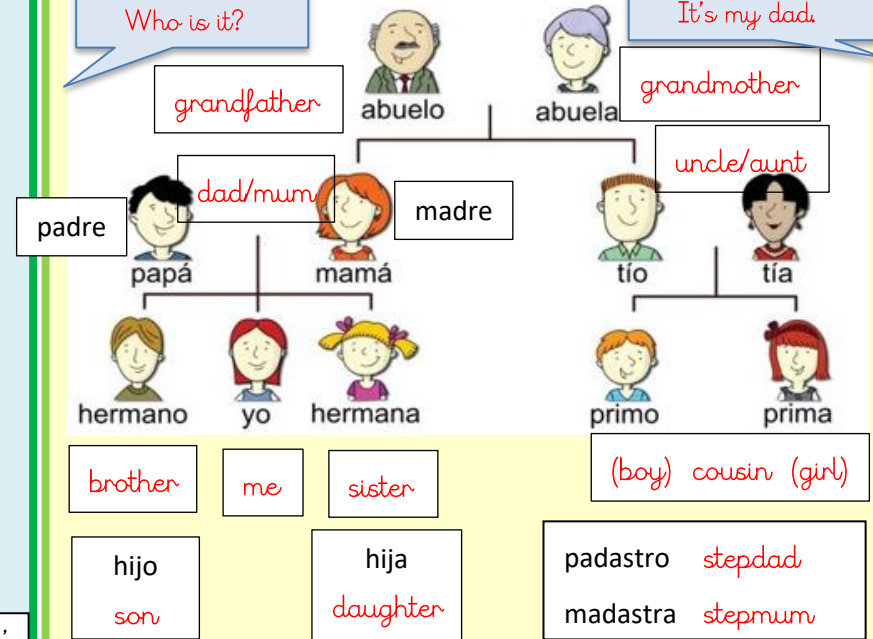


'Hola monstruo.'

hermano - ermano

helado - elado

i is pronounced as ee

hijo - eejo hija - eeja

primo/a - preemo/a

mi - mee

e is pronounced as ay

de - day padre - padray
