domingo	Sunday
lunes	Monday
martes	Tuesday
miércoles	Wednesday
jueves	Thursday
viernes	Friday
sábado	Saturday

Pronunciation tips

Phonics

'j' is pronounced 'ch' as in 'loch'
eg, rocho, narancha.

'i' as 'ee' eg. día - deea

'ñ' as 'ny' eg, años - anyos

'v' as 'b' eg. viernes - biernes

'¿Qué?' as 'kay'

The accent mark tells us to stress that particular sound eg. día, miércoles, sábado.
