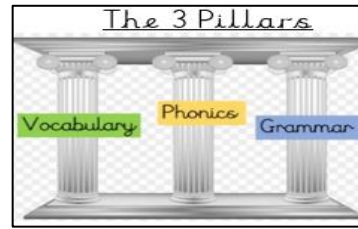

We already know that days of the week in Spanish begin with lower case letters, and months of the year do too.

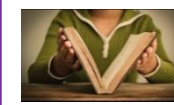
