EYFS

- Recognise and discuss common uses of information technology in school and outside of school.
- Recognise there are different types of media content.

YEAR

1

- Learn about the uses and purpose of technology in the classroom, at home, work and the world around them and how to use them.
- Access different types of media content on their device.

YEAR

2

- Learn about the numerous uses of online communication.
- Explore their own use of the internet and why it is important to stick to the rules. Learn where different types of media content can be found online.

YEAR

3

- Learn that the internet is a computer network.
- Learn the internet can provide multiple services.
- Explore a web sites journey from first request to appearing on the screen.
- Learn advanced web terminology e.g. URL.
- How to make judgements about the usefulness and accuracy of information.
- Learn about the term 'fake news'.
- Learn about what copyright is

YEAR

4

- Differentiate between apps that use the Internet, the school network or that are self contained on a device.
- To use computing to communicate and collaborate.
- Learn about documents and methods of collaboration
- How to identify Fake News.

YEAR

5

- Learn about different online communication tools/apps and how they could be used for different purposes.
- how and why information found on some sites will be biased.
- how to source copyright free materials to use in their digital projects.

- Learn about digital crimes and threats that might exist online.
- Learn about anti-virus software.
- Learn advanced web terminology.
