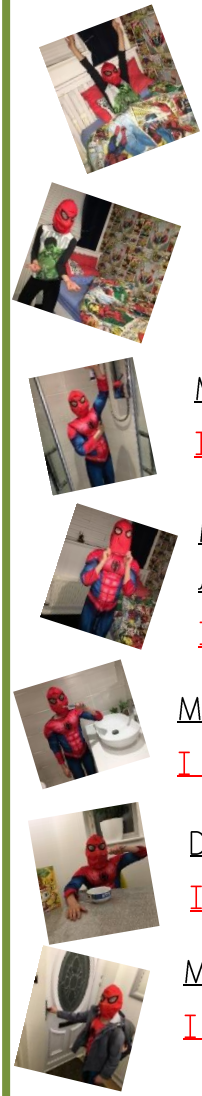

The day of the Innocent

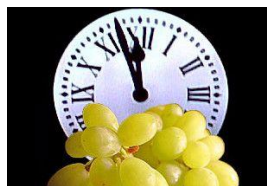

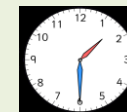
