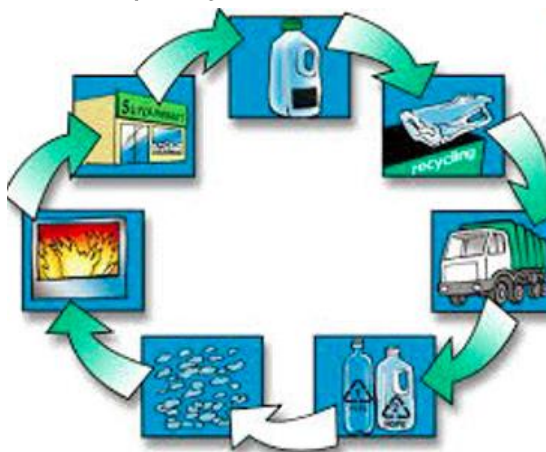
- Plastic is in a lot of things we use such as clothes, toys, and money.

Manmade material - material produced or made by humans.

Natural material - unchanged materials we find in nature e.g. coal and oil.

Single-use plastic - items made of plastic that are only used once before being thrown away.

Marine - animals/plants found in the sea.

Biodegradable - material that can be broken down by organisms.

Environment - everything that is around us. Both living and non-living things.

Sustainability - sensible use of natural resources that keeps up their supply in the future.
