Dead or alive?

Living

A living thing is alive. It is called an organism.



Dead

A dead thing has once been alive.



Non-living

A non-living thing has never been alive.

Food chain

Herbivore - animals that only eat plants.

Carnivore - animals that only eat other animals (meat).

Omnivore - animals that eat both plants and animals.

Habitat - a place that an animal or plant lives. Provides the animal with food, water and air (basic needs).

Microhabitat - within a habitat there are different microhabitats e.g. leaf litter in a forest.

Producer - an organism that makes its own food e.g. plants

Food chain - diagram that shows us how animals are linked by what they eat.
