### Human Digestive System



**Tendon** - a connective tissue attaching muscle to bone. **Joints**  
When a muscle contracts to move a joint, it is the tendon which pulls on the bone.



**Skeleton** - Inside the human body is the skeleton to support, protect and for movement. Some animals such as crabs have a skeleton on the outside of their body (exoskeletons)

**Bone** - the hard part of a skeleton. It can grow and repair itself.

**Muscle** - a bundle of tissue in an animal body that has the ability to contract.

**Contract** - to get shorter in length.

**Churn** - to shake up/mix. Stomach churns up our food to help break it down for digestion.

**Digestion** - the breakdown of the food we eat into smaller parts so it can be used by the body
