On their Saint's Day the specific colour team can come into school wearing their team colours instead of their uniform.

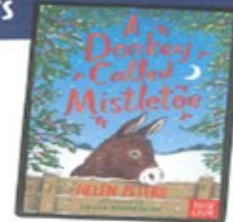
GREAT NEWS

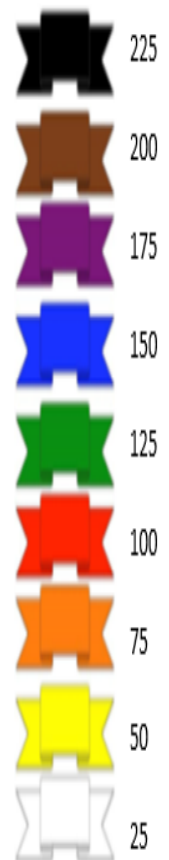
