Dear parents,

Year 1 have been busy with their phonics screening tests, and we could not be prouder of them. They have worked so hard to achieve the results they have this week, they really have been reading stars! A special shout out to the phonics team who have ensured every child have reached their potential or exceeded expectations, thank you!

Year 4 have also been busy this week with the national MTC check. The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) is a statutory on-screen assessment for Year 4 pupils in England. It measures a child's ability to fluently recall multiplication facts up to 12×12 . The check consists of 25 questions, with exactly six seconds to answer each one, and takes about five minutes to complete. The children have worked so hard over the year to either reach or exceed their own individual potential, with so many achieving 25/25 or just below this. We are amazed by their hard work and dedication and a special thank you to their teacher for working so hard with them over the year.

At the end of the year, as you are aware, our SENCo Mrs King will retire. She leaves big boots to fill, she has had such an impact on all the children and families at our school, especially in the last few months. Thankyou Mrs King, you will certainly be missed.

I am now thrilled to announce that Miss Ellis will take on this important role next year. Miss Ellis has all the skills and compassion to be an excellent SENCo and will work alongside me to ensure the provision in place for our most vulnerable children is the highest standard for all. Thank you Miss Ellis for all you will achieve in this role for our children and families, I am very much looking forwards to working alongside you.

Next week we have lots to look forward to including sports day, our musical concert and reception open evening for our new starters.

Regarding sports day, we have changed the format slightly this year to ensure you can all watch your children race. Please do sit along the track to ensure you all have a great view of your children in action. You are welcome to bring your own chairs, but school are also happy to provide chairs if needed. I politely ask that you do stay seated during this event on the opposite side to the children. This ensures the event is safe and fun for all.

As always, thank you for your continued support as we grow as a school community.

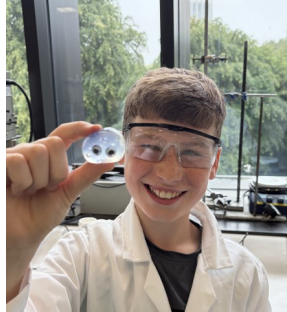
