As part of our ongoing commitment to providing the very best education for our pupils, we will be introducing a **Live Feedback Policy** from the Autumn Term.

This approach is rooted in educational research and best practice and reflects what we know has the greatest impact on pupil progress. Live feedback enables teachers to address misconceptions immediately, provide timely guidance during lessons and help children make improvements in real time. This means that feedback becomes part of the learning process rather than something that happens afterwards.

Our aim is to ensure that children receive high-quality feedback when it matters most, helping them to make rapid progress while continuing to develop independence and confidence as learners.

We will share further information with parents in September about how this approach will support teaching and learning across the school.

As we move towards the final days of the academic year, I would like to thank our children, staff and families for their continued support. It has been another week filled with achievement, determination and community spirit, and I am continually proud to be part of such a caring and successful school.
